Attendance Matters/ Asuntos de asistencia

Students must attend school. Any student that misses 18 days of school a year is considered chronically absent. Students that miss more than 20 days of school per year will be referred to CPS for educational neglect.

Drop off and Pick Up of Students

- Kiss and Go lanes are for dropping off and picking up. Please do not drop off in the red zones and have students exit the vehicle on the curb side of the road.
 - U-Turns are illegal in a school zone.
 - **DO NOT** leave your vehicle if you are double parked. This is also illegal and you can be fined for abandoning your car.
 - Be kind to the school staff as they are volunteering their time to keep students safe

Early Readers - Grades K-2

Students earn tokens and badges based on passed quizzes. Teachers set these yearly goals based on book level and expected daily reading time and see progress in a corresponding record book. The fun Accelerated Reader Friend character badges keep students excited to read and achieve their reading goals.



Independent Readers - Grade 3-5

Progress on reading goals is presented to students in an easy-to-understand dashboard that illustrates average % correct, average book level, and points earned. Students will be able to determine next steps to meet or maintain their goal with their progress page.
